## Florence Nightingale

#### FOUNDER OF MODERN NURSING

Florence Nightingale (12<sup>th</sup> May 1820 - 13<sup>th</sup> Aug 1910) was an English social reformer, statistician and the founder of modern nursing. Nightingale came to prominence while serving as a manager and trainer of nurses during the Crimean War, in which she organised care for wounded soldiers at Constantinople. She significantly reduced death rates by improving hygiene and living standards. Nightingale gave nursing a favourable reputation and became an icon of Victorian culture, especially in the persona of "The Lady with the Lamp" making rounds of wounded soldiers at night. Florence received many honours. She was invited to Windsor by Queen Victoria to receive The Royal Red Cross in 1833.

- They must have completed the GNM (General Nursing and Midwifery) Course.
- They must have completed a 10+2 program with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English as required topics.
- IELTS/TOFEL Scores

### ACADEMIC PROGRAMME IN B.Sc. ( NURSING)

Eligibility: Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually. In respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC the marks obtained in 3 core subjects shall be 40% instead of 45% for General category candidates.

Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.

**Age**: 17 years to be completed on 31st December in the year of admission. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.

Duration: 4 Years (8 Semester)
